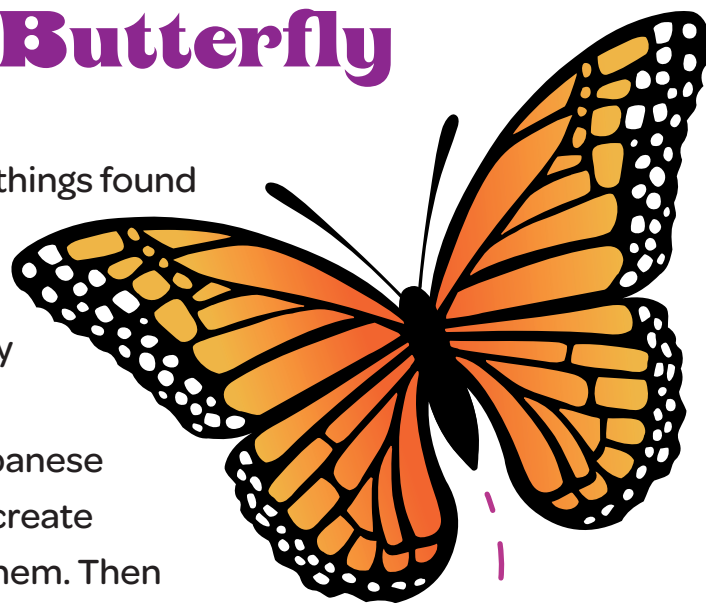


print & play **Dancing Butterfly**

The butterfly is a reminder of the beautiful things found in nature. These delicate winged creatures are a perfect symbol for the *Between Earth and Sky Journey*, because that is where they travel! In this book, girls learn how to make butterflies using origami, the traditional Japanese art of paper folding. Use our Print & Play to create butterfly wings and an armband to attach them. Then girls can flutter and dance among the trees and flowers.



Materials

Crayons and coloring supplies
Scissors
Paper (black recommended)
Clear tape

Instructions

- 1 Color in the butterfly wings.
- 2 Cut on dashed line.
- 3 For armband: Cut strips of paper about 3 inches wide by 9 inches long. (Length will vary based on width of upper arms.)
- 4 On the back of the wings, tape down the strip of paper, so it becomes a cylinder for your arm to fit into.

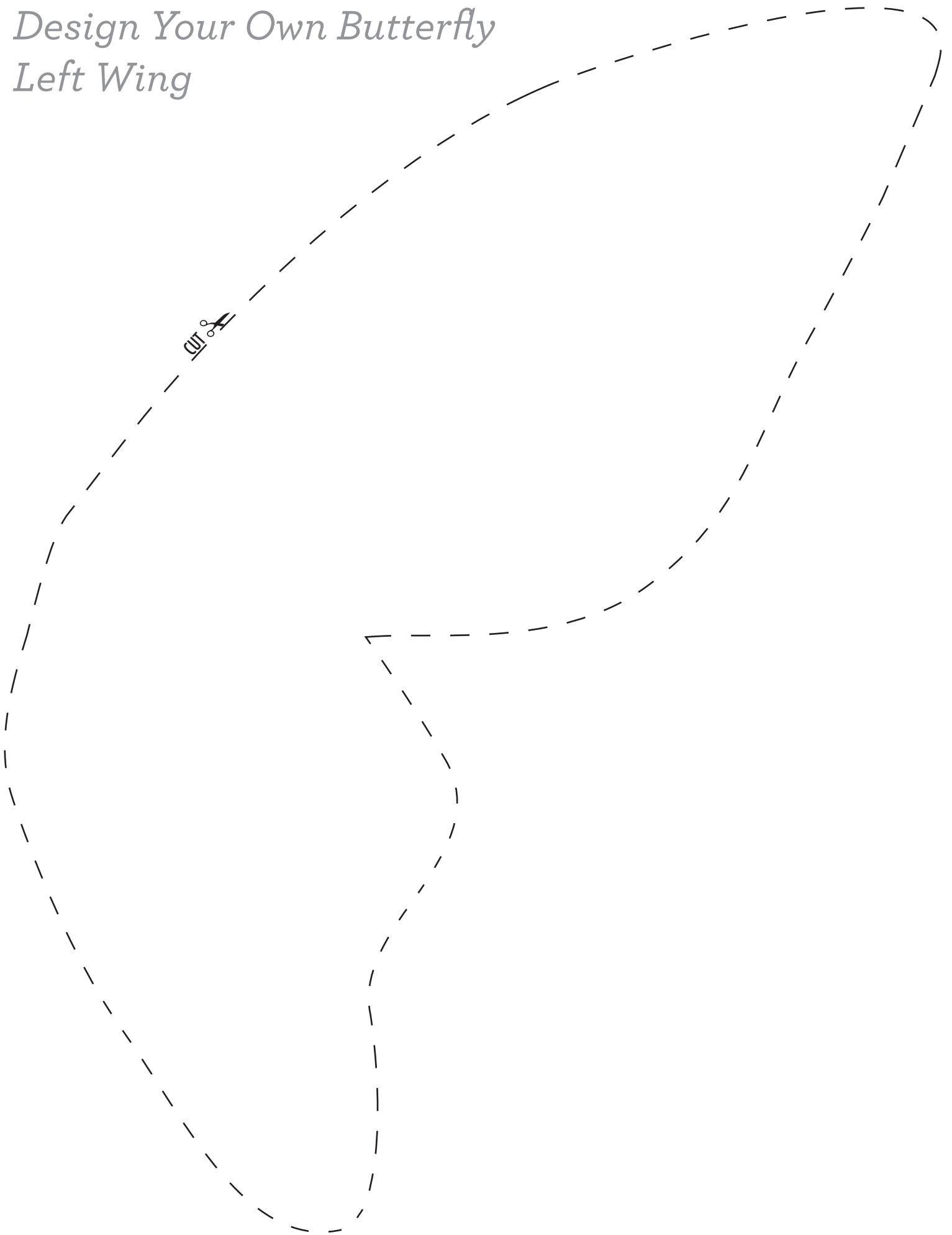
